## Ground Shark

The Ground Shark Extreme-Duty Brush Cutter attachment has a 72" cutting width and is designed to clear tough ground vegetation, brush and hardwoods up to 7" in diameter. Four blades with alternating bevels provide deep penetrating, self-clearing, axe-like cuts that spin on a heavy-duty retention disc for increased stability and smooth operation. Once the brush and small trees are removed, the small teeth on the bottom of the retention disc are used to grind the stump down below the surface. District 8 staff will evaluate this brush cutter for its ability to eliminate the need for multiple pieces of equipment to clear brush, stumps and unwanted vegetation from MNDOT's right of way.
